Communicate with on-coming operator (i.e.: special instructions, part, mold and machine performance).</li> <li>5. Perform work in accordance with applicable work, inspection and test instructions (includes duties stated for mold change responsibilities).</li> <li>6. Maintain cleanliness at work area(s) and perform required end of shift clean up (5 S system for workplace organization and cleanliness).</li> <li>7. Notify Supervisor/ Technician or Team Leader of any unusual events during the molding process (i.e. mold not producing correct number of cavities, cosmetic defects, dimensional discrepancies, out of ordinary noises from the molding machines or auxiliary equipment, etc.).</li> <li>8.
