What Roles do Pharmacists in Canada Perform?

### **Pharmacists**

### **Job Duties**

- Generally, pharmacists prepare and dispense medications and advise patients how to use them.
- They answer any health questions patients might have, check and fill prescriptions.
- Industrial pharmacists participate in the research, development, promotion and manufacturing of pharmaceutical products.
- Community and hospital pharmacists compound and dispense prescribed medications and provide consultative services to clients and health care providers.







### **Employment requirements**

- A university degree in pharmacy and a period of supervised practical training are required.
- Licensure is required in all provinces and territories for community and hospital pharmacists.

Every pharmacy, pharmacist, pharmacy technician, and pharmacy student in Manitoba must register with the College. You must enrol in Pharmacist's Gateway Canada and go through the Pharmacist Examining Board of Canada (PEBC) document evaluation process before applying to the college (COPM).

### **Different Paths to Registration for**

- Students and New Graduates
- Pharmacists Licensed Elsewhere in Canada
- Internationally-educated Pharmacists



### Pre-licensing steps: Enroll in Pharmacists' Gateway Canada

- Pass PEBC Evaluating and Qualifying Examinations. You must register with Cphm within 3 years after passing.
- You must meet language requirements set by the National Association of Regulatory Authorities (NAPRA).
- Exemptions apply.



# Application for Registration with the College of Pharmacists of Manitoba

 Complete the Cphm Application for Registration and Initial Licensure

#### **Attach Documents**

- Notarised documents
- PEBC Qualification Certificate
- Proof of language or exemption
- Letter of standing
- Criminal Record, Vulnerable Sector Search, and Adult and Child Abuse Registry Checks



- Submit Application and Supporting Documents to Cphm for Review and Approval
- Cphm processes a maximum of 5 international pharmacy graduate applications each month in the order they are received.

### Internship

- Complete a 600-Hour Internship
- You are responsible for finding a preceptor to oversee your internship.
- The pharmacist (preceptor) must complete a Preceptor Application
- You can use the College's pharmacy register to search for a practice site.



### **Complete Jurisprudence Examination**


- You are eligible to complete the Jurisprudence exams after completing 200 hours of internship and Cphm has received your first internship report
- You must achieve a min grade of 70% percent.
- You have 3 hours to complete the closed book exam at Cphm

### **College Processes Your Application and Licence**

 After completing registration and licensing requirements listed in steps 1 through 5, Cphm will process and send your licence to you.






