Each pallet audited will be reviewed with the order assembler in order to provide positive feedback or address concerns through corrective actions</li> <li>- The shift begins at 8:30 AM and can end anywhere between 2:30 PM to 5:00 PM</li> <li>- Must be available 5 days a week</li> <li>- Weekends are required as a new colleague with us, however, we try to have a balanced schedule to accommodate requests for time off.</li> </ul>
