Under the general direction of the Fabrication Supervisor, while demonstrating a commitment to quality, efficiency, and accuracy, the Fabricator is responsible for general labour tasks such as rolling, detailing parts, grinding, deburring, cleaning parts or completing parts the final assembly of parts products.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Read and interpret work orders.
- Operate metal cleaning equipment such as deburrers and grinders to remove excess welds, rust, scale and other material from surfaces of metal parts, castings and other metal products.
- Uses, cleans and safeguards inspection measurement and testing equipment (IMTE), such as callipers to accomplish actual results to identify and investigate any discrepancies and determines and acts as required to remedy the problem.
- Polish metal products to mirror finish.
- Cut, grind or chip excess metal from metal products using hand tools.
- Assist metalworking machine operators or other metalworkers.
- Sort metal sheets and parts, scrap metal and other materials.
- Clean work areas and equipment.
- Assemble products.
- Any other duties as assigned.
