

Process Operator- Temporary

MDI is one of the largest dairy operations in Manitoba and is a processor of speciality Milk Protein Concentrate (MPC) and Butter products that operates 24/7, 365 days a year.

We are currently seeking a **Temporary - Process Operator** at our Winnipeg, Manitoba facility to cover a 3-month period.

The Process Operator is a member of the MDI Team and as such, participants in team efforts to achieve departmental goals, and provides support to other roles within the dairy operations as required. This position does require the candidate to work 12-hour shifts including but not limited to weekend and holiday rotations.

A snapshot of what you will be doing (but not limited to):

- Prepare product, perform routine maintenance to ensure ongoing production operation, and shut down dryer at end of production run.
- Checks all incoming tanker loads for order, temperature, and other factors in accordance with the Quality Assurance.
- Responsible for the actual flow of all incoming milk products to its proper holding silos.
- Operate, Monitor, adjust and trouble-shoot in order to complete daily production targets.
- Complete batch sheets, record information from gauges, printouts and monitors and verify against standards; maintain shift logs and other required data for production of batch.
- Package and palletize finished product 20-25kg bags.
- Transport product to warehouse using forklift.
- Clean and sanitize equipment using chemicals and utilizing CIP and COP processes

- Two years experience in a manufacturing environment related to food or a similar industry. Dairy processing experience is an asset.
- Comprehension - able to understand and follow detailed instructions in English.

- Mechanical Aptitude – able to troubleshoot equipment or processes.
- Physically Capable - able to lift up to 25kgs frequently throughout the day to palletize product, able to work in Hot, Dusty, Confined Spaces or at heights periodically as required.
- Solid work ethic - Capability to work independently without constant supervision.
- Availability - Able to work required shift schedule including weekends and holidays.
- Safe Work Priority – you care about keeping yourself and co-workers safe.
- Computer skills - working proficiency in computerized environment: plus, Word, Outlook, and Excel an asset
