- Designs and develops Java applications for mission-critical systems, delivering high-availability and performance.
- Contributes in all phases of the development lifecycle.
- Writes well designed testable, efficient code.
- Creates and maintains unit and integration tests.
- Researches and estimates the impact of proposed changes to an application.
- Ensures software designs are in compliance with specifications, standards, architectural guidance and best practices.
- Contributes in all phases of the development lifecycle.

- Prepares and assists in the release of software components to production.
- Supports continuous improvement by investigating alternatives and technologies and presenting these for architectural review.
- Proactively anticipates technical, design and implementation risks and provides mitigation techniques to ensure successful implementation of the software applications.
- Prototypes designs for new technology and complex applications.
- Troubleshoots application problems and makes appropriate modifications to correct them.
- Documents software, testing and deployment procedures, as required.
- Performs other special assignments and related duties as assigned.
