- Demonstrate a safe and quality conscious approach to work and perform well in a self directed team environment

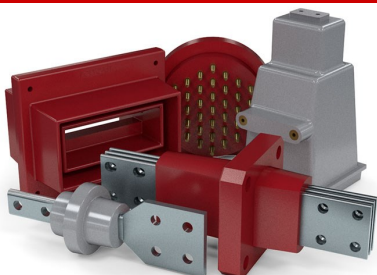
Work Conditions:
