Job Description

Main Duties

Under the direction of the Transportation Supervisor and Head Mechanic, this position will be responsible to inspect, diagnose, repair and service mechanical, electrical and electronic systems and components of school buses.

Employment requirements

- Preference will be given to candidates with a Truck and Transport Mechanic Red Seal Certificate, Automotive Service Technician Red Seal, Heavy Duty Equipment Red Seal Certificate, or relative work experience would be considered.
- Must have at least 2-3 years' experience in repair and school bus maintenance or a combination of truck and transport related repair and maintenance; and may include structural, mechanical, electrical and electronic vehicle systems, and components such as engines, cab, chassis and frames, brakes, steering, suspension, drive train, fuel systems and hydraulic systems, and perform preventative maintenance and diagnosis of vehicles.
- A minimum of a class 5 driver's license in good standing is required, with the ability to upgrade if requested.
- Experience using Computer Diagnostic Software for Motor Vehicles would be an asset.
- Must have good interpersonal skills and the ability to communicate clearly and concisely, both orally and in writing, as well as understand and follow verbal and written instructions.
- Ability to work independently and within a team environment, and possess good problem-solving and analytical skills.
- Must be familiar with and adhere to safe workplace practices and requirements as per Workplace Safety and Health and other provincial regulations as they apply to a vehicle maintenance facility.
- Must own or be prepared to purchase a complete set of mechanical hand tools.
- Must be free of any physical restrictions that would prevent performing the manual labour components of the position.
- Must be able to work in an environment involving exposure to dust, noise, and extreme temperature/weather conditions.

- Willingness to complete upgrading necessary to maintain appropriate knowledge & skills, training may include school bus safety certification after completion of 6 months' probation.
- Experience using MS office software application would be an asset
- Uniforms/coveralls and a bi-annual safety footwear allowance are provided as per Collective Agreement
