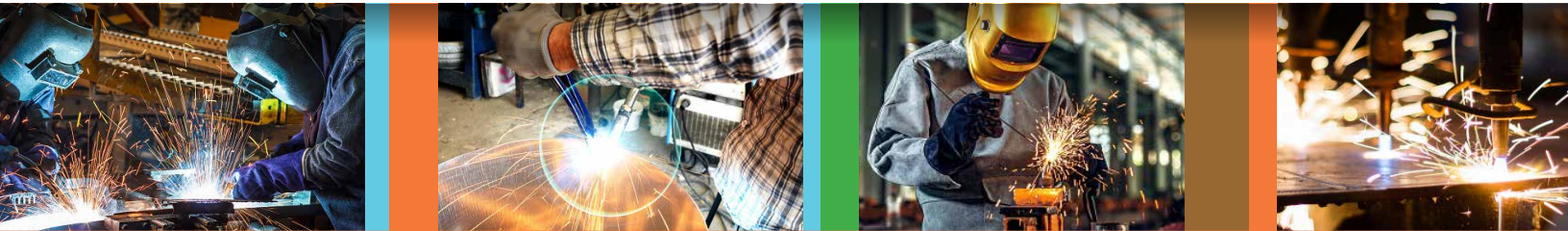

## Eligibility Criteria

- Immigrant or Refugee Status
- Language Levels CLB 1–4
- Available to be in class Monday – Friday from 8:00am to 4:00pm
- Physical ability to do the job duties (i.e. bending, lifting, reaching)
- Employment ready!

## Training & Job Details

- Students receive 10 weeks language training for Welding.
- Receive training in both Industrial Metal Fabrication and Industrial Welding.
- Additional instruction provided in: (WHMIS), Shop Safety, trade related Mathematics, Blueprint Reading, Introduction to Metals, and Resume Preparation.
- Students are exposed to the production environment, not only at the training facility, but at an external business.
