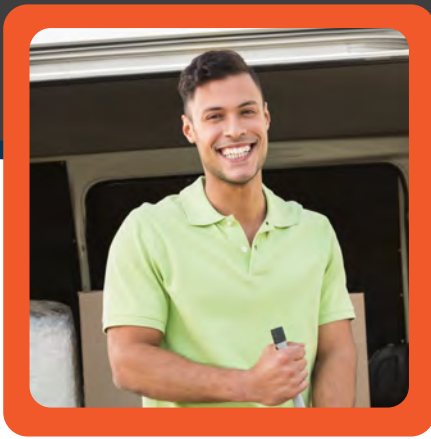
Free Training:

EAL Programs will improve English skills and vocabulary to prepare for Occupation Specific Training

OCCUPATION SPECIFIC TRAINING AND WORK PLACEMENT

Occupation Training will prepare clients for work and includes work placement

Eligible Applicants will:

- ➔ Have come to Canada as a refugee or refugee claimant
- ➔ Have a Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) between 1-3
- ➔ Be legally entitled to work in Canada
- ➔ Be 18 years or older
- ➔ Be currently unemployed and looking for work
- ➔ Be able to attend full-time, Monday to Friday from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm
- ➔ Have childcare in place including summer months (if applicable)
- ➔ Accept employment offered to them at the end of the program
