Description

The Maintenance Transportation Assistant is responsible for always supervising their individuals while on their support times within the Day Program or in the community. The Maintenance Transportation Assistant shall ensure the individuals have entered their home and/or have been met by team/family.

We provide well maintained homes that best meet the needs of our individuals. We offer caring staff and a person-centered approach based on the concept of "Gentle Teaching".

Duties

- Work with Day Program Manager to meet the transportation needs of new participants, transporting the Day Program people on outings and to appointments.
- Maintain the bus, including gas, washing, maintenance, repairs, yearly certifications, first aid kits, winter plug in
- Maintains appropriate records and reports, incidents, individual logs, fire drills, mileage, float funds etc. and information as required by Hearthstone and/or Family Services & Housing and Transport Canada.
- Train support teams on safe operation of the Wheelchair Vans part of the Day Program Team, spend work hours of their day with assigned individuals.
