Duties

The primary purpose of the Family Treatment Counsellor role is to provide professional addictions counselling including assessment and evaluation, treatment planning, client education & life skills, individual and group counselling, referrals, service coordination and documentation.

Qualification

- Diploma/degree from a recognized College/University in the field of addictions/social work, or a counselling certificate from a recognized program with addictions and mental health related training and a combination of training/experience.
- Demonstrated awareness of impacts of colonization on Indigenous people, and particularly the family unit.
- Knowledge and experience in traditional and contemporary healing practices.
- Ability to work with Elders, Healers and Clinicians within a group setting or individually.
- Ability to function in crisis and/or pressure situations.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Facilitation and/or presentation skills.
